My Rotary is a great resource for all club members to use. It has many great resources and information about Rotary programs. Club secretary Adrian has written down the steps below for members who have not used it before to register and start using the website.

# **Accessing My Rotary**

- 1. Google 'My Rotary'
- 2. Click on 'Create an Account' or 'Register'
- 3. Fill in the information required on the Create an Account page and after checking the box 'I'm not a robot' click on 'CONTINUE'.
- 4. An email will be sent to your email address. Follow the instructions in the email to activate your new account.

- 5. Once you are logged in, a good place to start exploring the website is the **LEARNING & REFERENCE** page.
- 6. Hovering the cursor over the **LEARNING & REFERENCE** heading brings up a menu. Click on 'Learning Centre'.
- 7. A page with Courses by Topic appears. Click on VIEW for General.
- 8. 18 Items appear. Select 'Getting Started With the Learning Centre'. This is a 15 minute course at the end of which you will be familiar with how to proceed with the other courses.

There is a wealth of interesting and useful information on this website. Make sure you have a cup of tea/coffee at hand when you start exploring. Cheers, Adrian
