We then moved onto the Club Night. After the formalities the arrangements for the setting up and running of the Giant Book Sale were outlined by Trevor Watt.

Then Youth Director Lisa Burgess gave a report which included the arrangements for the re-scheduled Rotary Youth Leadership Award (RYLA) commencing 27th June. She also spoke about the Rotary Club of Sale Young Leader Awards which were given to a Year 10 or 11 student at each of the local Secondary Schools at the end of 2021, and the low level district grant which together with a club contribution enabled two scholarships for students suffering economic hardship at Sale College (\$500- each for computer and text books).

Currently Lisa is looking into the arrangements for MUNA (Model United Nations Assembly), NYSF (National Youth Science Forum) and the SANTOS Science Experience.

The successful Women's Day raffle proceeds of over \$500 will go to the Empowering Girls Project. Empowering girls is a Rotary Bangladesh project that supports building clean toilets and hygiene facilities that allow girls to attend school.

Kerry McMillan then gave a report on the progress towards replacing the sign on the westward approach to Sale that displays all the logos of the clubs, etc. that meet in Sale. A new sign has been designed and the council have agreed to pull down the old sign and erect the new one which will cost approx. \$2,000-. The Lions club have offered to pay half the costs. It will have space at the bottom to display advertising for coming events.

Kerry has also talked with the Greyhounds Club about putting a 'Rotary meets here' sign near the club's entrance and a smaller one on the fence near the entrance to Graze. We might be able to get a community grant from the Greyhounds towards the cost of these signs.

President Philip Davis then spoke about the Sky Hydrant project for Timor Leste that we had agreed to help fund. It has been delayed due to COVID but hopefully will go ahead soon with some modifications in that it is envisaged that much of the infra structure will be pre-engineered and sent in shipping containers to reduce the amount of personnel involved.

Philip and Don Ripper have erected 10 signs that will inform the general public about the coming Wetlands Trail project. Don Ripper won the raffle.
