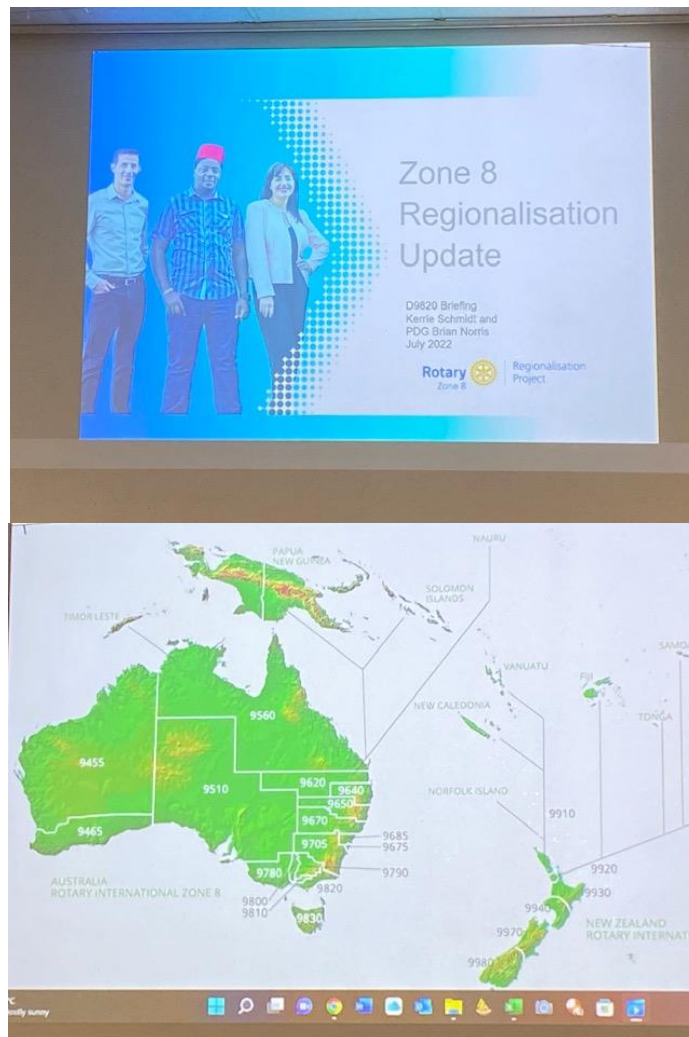


**Kerrie Schmidt being thanked and presented with a pen by President Rob McKimm**  
President Rob welcomed Kerrie Schmidt and her husband Brian Norris. He reminded everyone that Kerrie was a fellow Rotarian in the Sale central club for many years, who filled many roles in the club.

Kerrie had come to talk about the Zone 8 Regionalisation project. She said that her presentation was available on the Rotary website. Each club will have a vote in the first two weeks of September, failure to vote will be taken as a 'no'.

This is a project that Kerrie is passionate about, as she believes that it shows a way forward for Rotary to adapt and change and face up to the challenges which include declining membership. She thinks that if the project goes ahead it will help to cut red tape and make Rotary more affordable. The pilot is due to run

until 2026.
