Rob announced that RI President Jennifer Jones has committed Rotary to a \$150 million US contribution for the fight against polio. Rob also promoted the next district conference at Cape Schank on 24th February 2023. He then handed over to PDG Don Ripper to talk about next year's RI Conference in Melbourne. This will be the culmination of a very long process. Last Melbourne RI Conference was in 1993, but there have been conferences in Australia about every ten years.

Both Don and Rob agreed that attending a RI Conference is an extraordinary experience with the chance to interact with Rotarians from around the world and hear world class speakers, and experience huge market places, etc. and find out more about Rotary. Don said that they will need 17,000 delegates to break even.

PP Philip Davis spoke about planning for Rotary Race the Rubeena which will be held on 2nd April 2023. Gerard Callinan will be Race Director again, and he will enlist some runners (as Friends of Rotary) to help on the committee but Philip is looking for Rotarians to join the committee. Jeanette has left pro-forma materials

that set out all the organisation required. Colin Adams has agreed to help, but more help is needed. Also, we need to make decisions on what we are putting the funds raised towards, suggestions will be welcomed.

Philip also spoke on the Wetlands Trail. He will be talking with Parks Victoria re signage- both interpretive and directional. Lisa Burgess announced that the club had been successful in its district grant application for the scholarship to support Sale College students. She also reminded members that next week we will be hearing from our club delegate at RYLA, Michael Brandon who will be bringing another RYLA participant with him.

The possibility of having a Rotary Club of Sale stall at next year's Sale show has been flagged. Colin Adams won the raffle.

SALE SHOW GATEKEEPERS INSTRUCTIONS 2022

EVERYBODY PAYS FOR ENTRY UNLESS THEY HAVE A VALID TICKET. However, for this show children (18 and under) are admitted free. See ticket board for examples of valid tickets. **Trade pass wrist bands must be worn to be valid.**

PATRONS WITH PREPAID SHOW TICKETS must have tickets clipped by gatekeepers on Friday and on Saturday ticket is to be retained by gatekeepers. These actions ensure that the tickets are used only once each day. The small tear off portion of Show Ticket admits one adult only. Ticket complete admits two adults. If two adults present then both portions of ticket are clipped.

ADMIT ONE TICKETS are used to facilitate entry control at McGhee St and the pedestrian gate when required.

EFTPOS MACHINES will be available at each gate.

GREYHOUND CLUB PATRONS are to be directed to enter via the gate in Dawson St next to the railway line; otherwise, they pay to enter like everyone else.

SHOW TICKETS are to be sold, after clipping, on Friday only. Families may enter at show ticket rate on Saturday but no show ticket is to be issued. All tickets presented on Saturday are to be retained by gatekeepers.

PENSIONER means age, service or disability pensioners only.

PASSOUTS stamps may be given at any time both days.

PROBLEMS OR DISPUTES should be referred to the gate supervisors Keith Miller (by radio or telephone 0432 360 442) and Andrew Widdis by radio or when he visits your ticket box. Failing that the secretary may be contacted on 51442603. **The pre-set radio channel is for gatekeepers only and should be monitored at all times,** not just for disputes and instructions but also for help with safety and emergency issues that may arise.

VEHICLE ENTRY after 10am is limited to essential vehicles only, meaning competitors with animals and tradesmen or trade exhibitors. Contact Keith if in doubt or if a dispute arises.

SECURITY PERSONEL will be on duty at each gate from about 5pm on Friday to assist with crowd control and to check bags for alcohol, so work with them as a team.

GATEKEEPERS are required to wear Rotary themed high-vis vests that will be available in each ticket box. Leave vest behind at finish of your shift.

GOVERNMENT REQUIREMENT this year is to record the exact number of people entering the show. Each gate will have a sheet where a running tally of adults, pensioners and children can be kept.

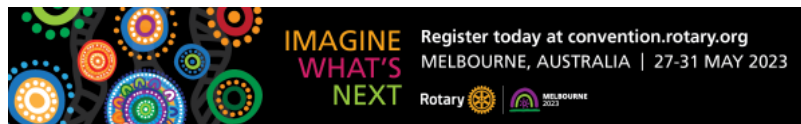
